Admission Information and Requirements

Admission to Grambling State University Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program, RN-BSN option, is contingent upon the student maintaining an unencumbered Registered Nurse license and satisfactory results of a drug screen. Information on how to obtain both reports will be provided upon acceptance. The School of Nursing has sole discretion to deny acceptance based on information contained in either of these two reports.

1. APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION TO GRAMBLING STATE UNIVERSITY

Students who are not currently enrolled at Grambling State University must first apply and be accepted to the university. You may apply to Grambling State University via the Admissions Office at www.gram.edu. If you experience difficulties or have questions regarding the admission process, contact the Admissions Office at 318-274-6183.

2. APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION TO SCHOOL OF NURSING BSN PROGRAM

The application for admission should be completed accurately and must be submitted on or before the submission deadline listed.

. Incomplete applications will not be considered for admission to the School of Nursing.

3. OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS

Grambling State University School of Nursing (GSUSON) will be accepting unofficial transcripts with the nursing application. It is the applicant's responsibility to have all transcripts, from all colleges/universities attended, forwarded to GSUSON in a timely manner.

4. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- a. Complete all required pre-nursing courses by end of semester of application.
- b. Earn a grade of "C" or higher and an overall grade point average (GPA) of 2.8 in pre-nursing courses.
- c. Earn a grade of "C" or higher and a GPA of 2.8 in all science courses: BIOL 207, BIOL 207L, BIOL 208, BIOL 208L, BIOL 304, CHEM 105, CHEM 107, NUR 225
- d. Hold current licensure

5. NOTIFICATION TO APPLICANTS

Applicants will be notified, by postal or Grambling State University's official electronic mail, of admission status 2 -4 weeks after the application cycle closes. No information of acceptance or denial to the program will be given to any applicant by phone or electronic text messaging. Official letters will be sent from Grambling State University School of Nursing BSN Program only. Applicants must indicate, in writing, their acceptance by the date stated in their acceptance letter in order to secure their place in the program.

NOTE: The turnaround time is very quick. Be ready to respond, and if needed, register and pay any associated fees.
